MOTLEY OF FOLKTALES & FABLES - SPECIAL ASSEMBLY

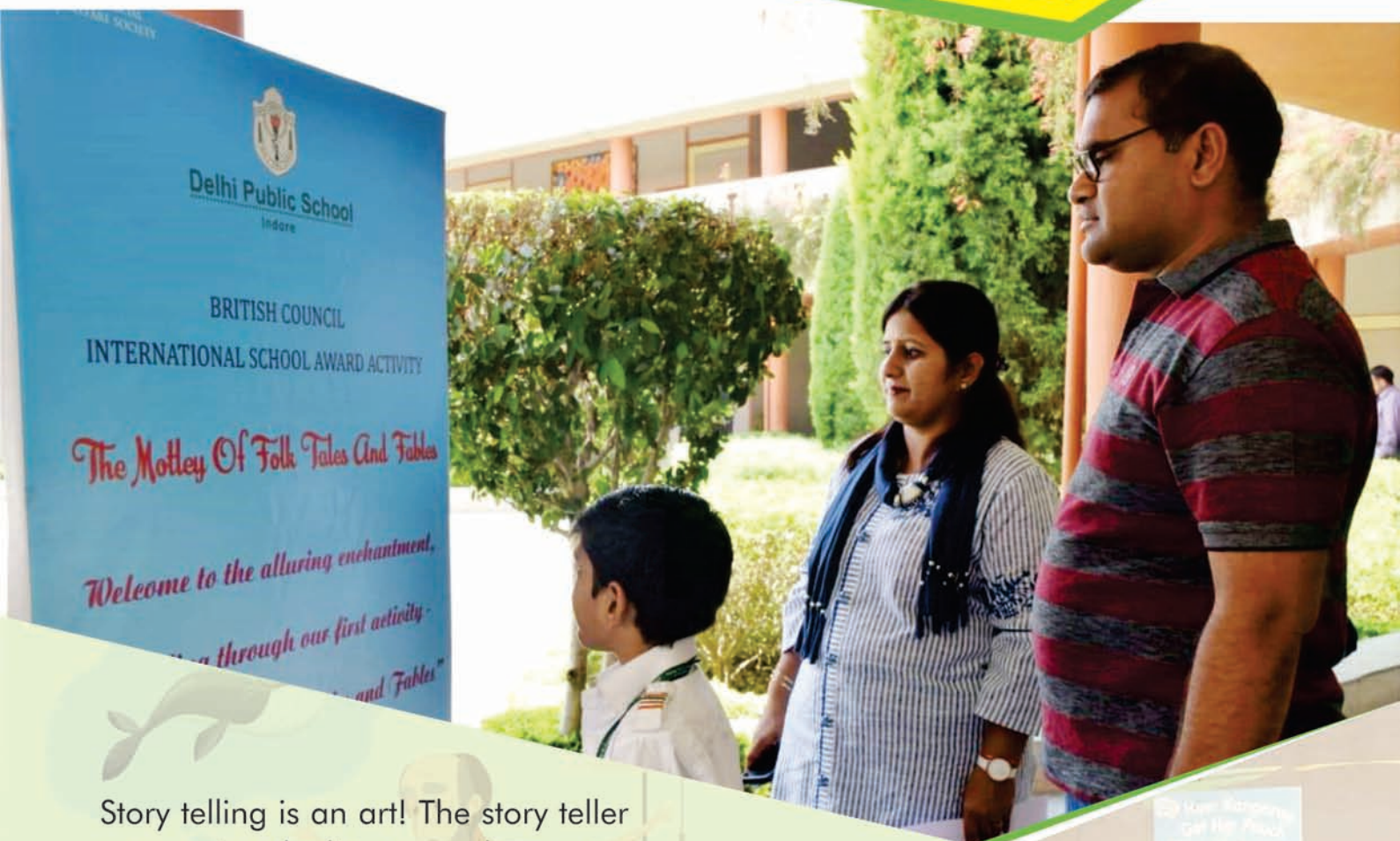
